



## **MINI-TANK RULES:**

1. For guest safety we are a Field Paint Only facility, no exceptions
2. Before entering netted areas / fields of play:
  - a. Tank filling performed only by The Combat Zone employees, no exceptions
  - b. Put on mask prior to entering netted areas
3. When inside the netted areas:
  - a. **KEEP MASK/HELMET FULLY ON AT ALL TIMES WHILE WITHIN THE NETTED AREAS WITHOUT FAIL** – failure to do so may result in ejection from the facility
  - b. Do not remove a mini tank from the netted area / field of play you are inside
  - c. Do not shoot referee or Combat Zone employees
  - d. Driving:
    - i. **DO NOT** collide with other tanks or field features (props, drums, logs, trees etc). This includes using the tanks as bumper cars, ramming other vehicles or field features etc. Failure to do so may result in ejection from the facility
      1. Unintended collision will result in a warning, subsequent occurrences will result in your withdrawal from the battle
      2. Intentional collision will result in your immediate withdrawal from the battle

NOTE: Unintended vs. intentional collision is solely the opinion of the attending Combat Zone employee
    - ii. Do not exit your tank during a battle – wait for a Combat Zone employee to:
      1. Signal the end of a battle
      2. Raise the tank body to allow your safe departure from the vehicle
    - iii. Avoid traversing slopes – engage slopes in a head-on manner
  - e. Hit shots:
    - i. A “hit” is counted as follows:
      1. Only turret and head shots count
      2. Paintball must explode on those areas
      3. After a hit occurs you are subject to a min. 50’ retreat prior to respawning/restarting
    - ii. Shots on already-hit tanks do not count
  - f. Pausing or Ending battles:
    - i. Combat Zone employee will signal a pause or end to a battle using a whistle. Upon hearing the whistle stop driving and shooting immediately.
  - g. If you run out of ammunition return mini tank to your team’s spawn/start location

- h. If you need any assistance at any time raise your hand and a Combat Zone employee will assist you – remain in your tank
    - i. For any disagreements Combat Zone referee adjudication is final
- 4. Before leaving netted areas:
  - a. KEEP MASK ON until outside the netted area
- 5. When finished:
  - a. Return all gear to a Combat Zone employee
